Event Placement. This indicates what place a child swam in this event. For individual events, place ribbons are given out to the top 6 places. For relays, ribbons are given to the top 3 places.

Event Information, including event number and event type

Invitational Qualifying Times. The Northwest Aquatic League (NWAL) sponsors several end of season invitational swim meets. The top swimmers can attend Ponderosa, the next is All Stars. Swimmers can attend these meets if they swim a qualifying time at any NWAL meet during the season.

Invitational Qualifier. At SCF home swim meets, the "P111" indicates this swimmer has qualified to swim this event at the Ponderosa invitational meet. An "AS11" means that this swimmer has qualified for the All Stars meet.

At some AWAY meets, there may be additional words such as RED or BLUE. Some teams choose to swim an additional invitational meet called "Red, White, and Blue". The Sharks do not swim at this meet. The Sharks swim only the All Stars and Ponderosa Invitational meets.

Scoring Points. For individual events, 1st place earns 5 points, 3 for 2nd place and 1 for 3rd place. Ribbons are awards for 6 places even though the team only gets points for 3 places. On relays, points are awarded only for 1st place (5 points) and 2nd place (2 points)

Disqualifications (DQ). A disqualification indicates the swimmer made an error while swimming the event. This can be for a number of reasons as each stroke, other than freestyle, has specific DQ factors. These are covered both in the Sharks handbook and the NWAL rule book, both which can be found on the SCF Sharks website.
